Getting Ready

The Studio was professionally cleaned with additional service by our staff.

We added steam cleaning to all floors nightly for added protection.

A sink will be available outside the building for hand-washing if desired.

Basic Guidelines

Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the studio.

We request that everyone inside the studio wear a face covering.

Classes will be let out 10 minutes early so that staff can wipe down all surfaces.

One bathroom will be available for use with an attendant to wipe down after each use. Please only use if necessary.

One bathroom will be available for hand washing if necessary.

Drinking fountains and vending machines will not be available. Dancers need to bring their own water.

The lobby will be closed. No seating will be available in common area.

Only One Parent per dancer of our youngest dancers, approximately 3-6 yrs old allowed in studio.

Teachers will not use physical contact with students for correction.

Dancers

Dancers will wait outside in cars until entry designated by teacher.

Dancers will be assigned an entry door to space out traffic.

Dancers must have waiver signed to enter their first class.

Dancers will receive hand sanitizing upon entry and temperature may be taken. No student will be allowed in with a temperature.

Upon entry and staying 6 feet apart, dancers will go to individually marked spot in classroom placing small bag in individually marked spot.

Dancers will not be allowed in restrooms to change clothes.

Dancers need to wear their hair in a bun to prevent touching the face.

Dancers are asked to maintain social distancing.

Only students with multiple classes should bring a snack.

All dancers in Level 1 classes and above should wear tight-fitting dance clothes with those in Ballet I or above wearing black.

Dancers are encouraged to continue with zoom classes instead of in-studio classes if that is what a family prefers.

We appreciate all of our students/parents abiding by our safety precautions. People not abiding will politely be asked to leave.
